Susan Campbell Park

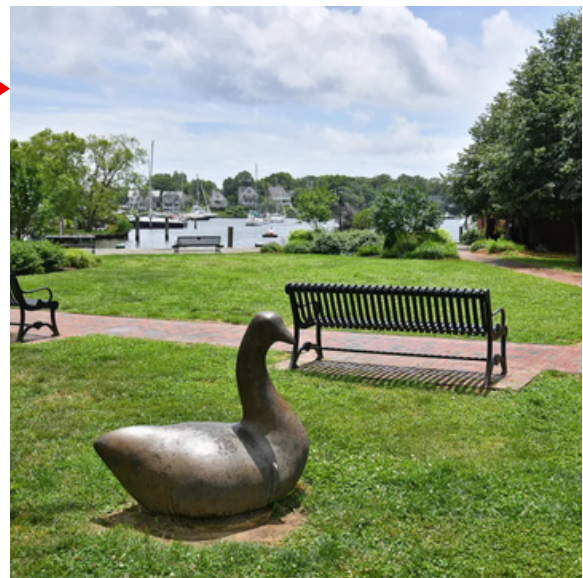
Dock St., Annapolis

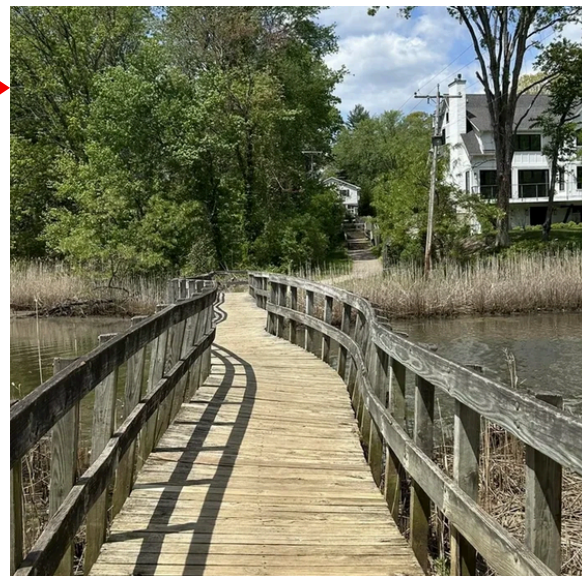
Acton's Cove Waterfront Park 14 South St, Annapolis

Acton's Landing Park is a cozy waterfront spot on Spa Creek featuring walking paths, a dinghy dock, and a small playground. Keep an eye out for the charming bronze duck statues nestled in the grass—they're a local favorite and perfect for a quick photo op.



Truxtun Park 273 Hilltop Ln, Annapolis,

Truxtun Park offers hiking and biking trails, boat launches, and plenty of space to play. With dedicated pickleball and tennis courts, playgrounds, and more, it's a go-to spot for outdoor fun and active days by the water.



Historic Landmarks



The beautiful Maryland State House is the oldest state capitol in continuous legislative use and is the only state house ever to have served as the nation's capitol. It's open to the public every day from 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.



The U.S. Naval Academy is a must-visit for its stunning architecture, rich military history, and role in shaping future Navy and Marine Corps officers since 1845. Walk the grounds to explore historic landmarks.



The William Paca House & Garden is a beautifully restored 18th-century mansion once home to a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Its elegance and peaceful walled garden offer a step back into colonial Annapolis.



The Banneker-Douglass-Tubman Museum in Annapolis is Maryland's official museum of African American heritage, celebrating the legacy of Black leaders through exhibits, art, and cultural programs in a historic 1874 church.

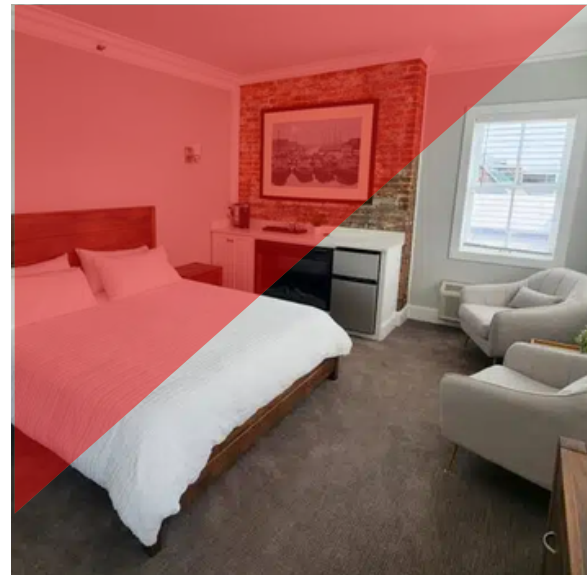

Steeped in history, the hotel reveals its original architecture along Chancery Lane—one of the most photographed spots in Annapolis for its iconic view of the illuminated State House dome. Legend has it George Washington once walked this very path in 1783 after resigning his commission. Inside, guests can enjoy a refined 1920s-style cocktail bar serving breakfast, lunch, and dinner in timeless style.





Restaurants & Bars

Chessie's Wharf

Chessie's Wharf is located in West Annapolis - a neighborhood spot right outside of downtown Annapolis and just across from the Naval Academy stadium. This is the perfect spot to escape the crowds of downtown, enjoy a beer, grab a smash burger, and have fun with the whole family. You've got to go to checkout their unique singing fish wall - yup, that's right. An entire wall of the classic singing fish decoration that all sing in unison at the top of each hour. Bread & Butter Kitchen

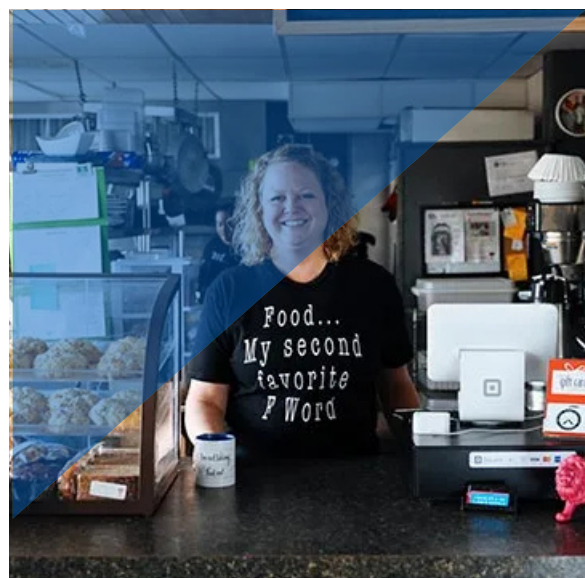

Vida Taco Bar



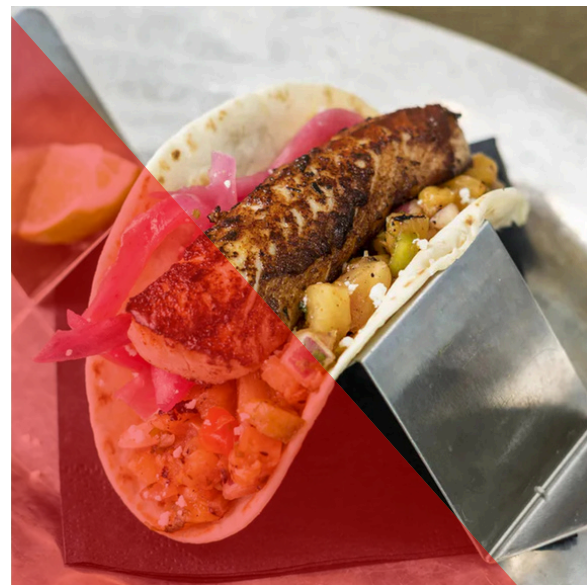
